UCF-UFF PRIVILEGES

4 3.1 Use of Facilities and Services. Subject to the rules of the Board and the
5 Universities, the UCF-UFF shall have the right to use University facilities for meetings
6 and all other services on the same basis as they are generally available to other
7 University-related organizations, which are defined as follows:

9 University-related Groups and Organizations, groups directly related to
10 University operations or the University community, which may or may not
11 receive budgetary support. Examples of such groups include student
12 organizations, honor societies, fraternities, sororities, alumni associations,
13 faculty committees, direct support organizations, the United Faculty of
14 Florida, etc.

16 3.2 Communications.

17 (a) UCF-UFF may post bulletins and notices relevant to its position as the
18 collective bargaining agent on existing bulletin boards in specific locations mutually
19 selected by the University and the UCF-UFF Chapter in the course of consultation
20 pursuant to Article 2, Consultation. All materials placed on the designated bulletin
21 boards shall bear the date of posting and may be removed by the University after having
22 been posted for a period of thirty (30) days. In addition, such bulletin boards may not be
23 used for exclusive collective bargaining representation.

25 (b) The University will place a link in an appropriate place on the UCF web
26 site to the UCF-UFF web site..

28 3.3 Board and University Documents. The University shall make the following
29 documents available by links on the University web site:

30 (a) the minutes of the meetings of the Board;

32 (b) Board rules published under the Administrative Procedure Act; and

34 (c) the University's operating budget.
