NOTICE OF TELEPHONE HEARING
AND PREHEARING ORDER
(FIFTY-THREE DAY EXTENSION)

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that, pursuant to Section 447.503, Florida Statutes (2008), and Florida Administrative Code Chapter 28-106, an evidentiary hearing will be conducted on June 1, 2009, at 9:00 a.m., in the University of Central Florida, Office of the General Counsel, Millican Hall, Room 360, 4000 Central Florida Boulevard, Orlando, Florida. I will contact the parties at telephone number (407) 823-2482.

The Commission has determined that this case is appropriate for a telephone hearing. Either party may elect to appear or present witnesses at the Commission offices in Tallahassee or at the above-listed hearing site. I will contact the parties telephonically from the Commission offices in Tallahassee. The Commission's court reporter will be at the above-listed hearing site.

If either party has a specific objection to a telephone hearing, the objection must be filed with the Clerk of the Commission, with a clear statement of supporting facts, within **ten** days from today. Failure to object will constitute a waiver of all objections to a telephone hearing.

At least **twelve** days before the date of the hearing, the parties must file with the Commission and deliver to each other a prehearing statement identifying:

- a. all disputed issues of material fact to be presented for resolution;
- b. any and all legal questions to be presented for resolution;

- c. any witnesses to be called at the hearing, except rebuttal witnesses, and the relevant issues about which each witness is expected to testify; and
- d. any outstanding motions or procedural questions to be resolved.


If a prehearing conference is scheduled, the parties will:

- a. present and discuss prehearing stipulations; and
- b. present any other relevant prehearing agreements entered into by the parties.

The parties should file their exhibits with the Commission and deliver copies to each other no later than **seven** days before the hearing. These exhibits must be accompanied by a list identifying each exhibit with specificity in numerical order.

If you are a person with a disability who needs any accommodation in order to participate in this proceeding, you are entitled, at no cost to you, to the provision of certain assistance.
