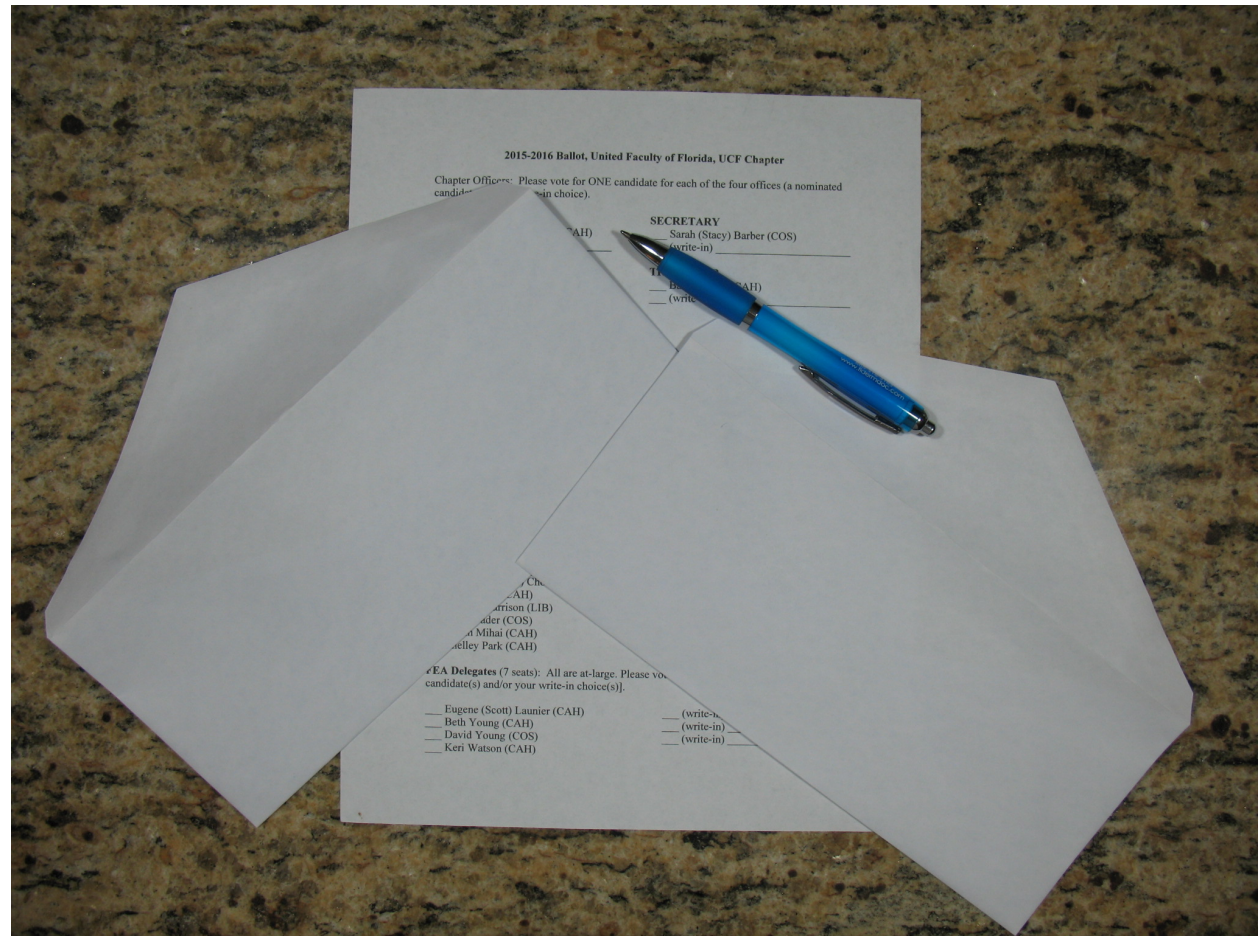

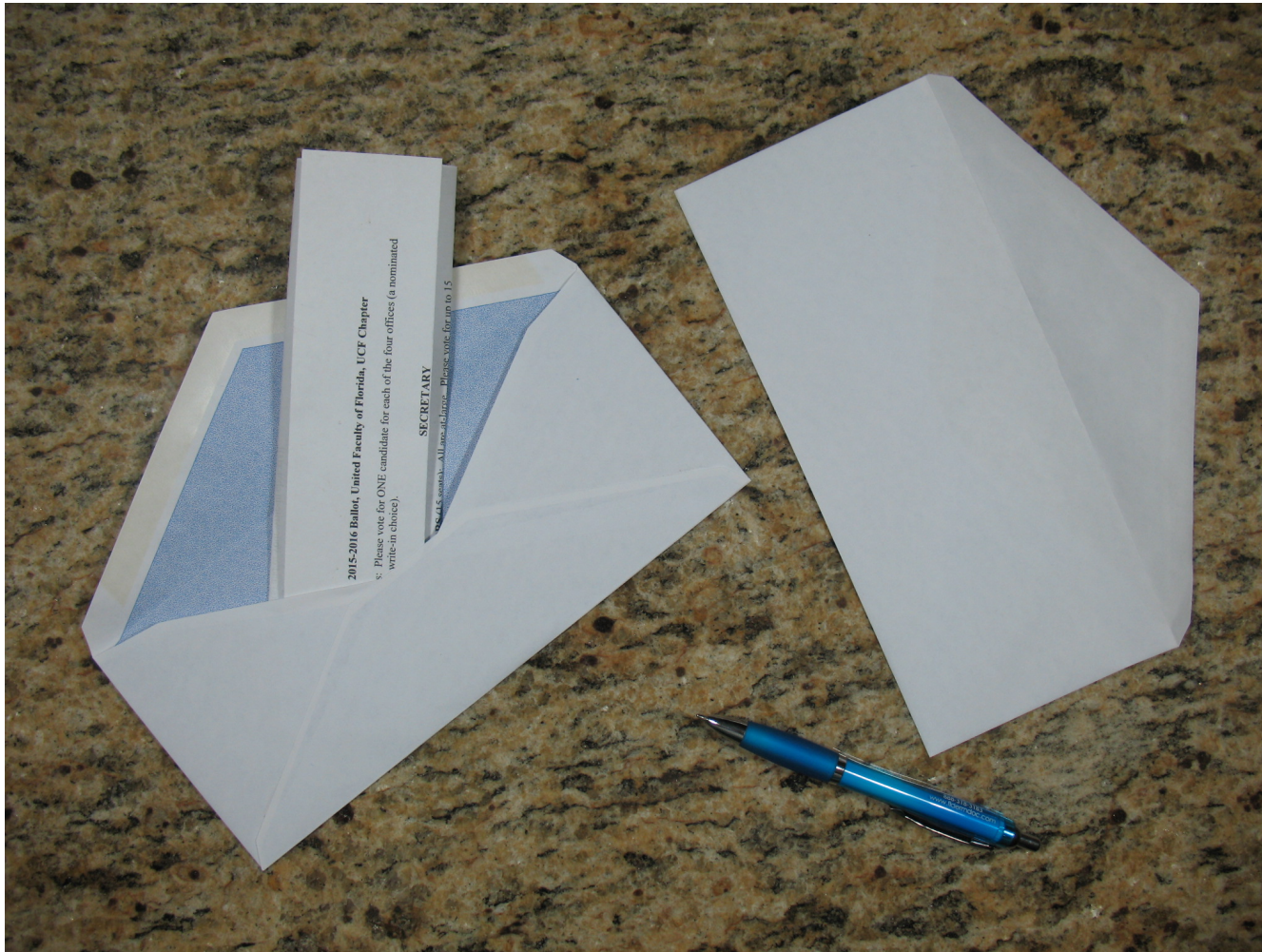
# This is what you need:

- 1 Ballot
- 2 Envelopes
- 1 Pen



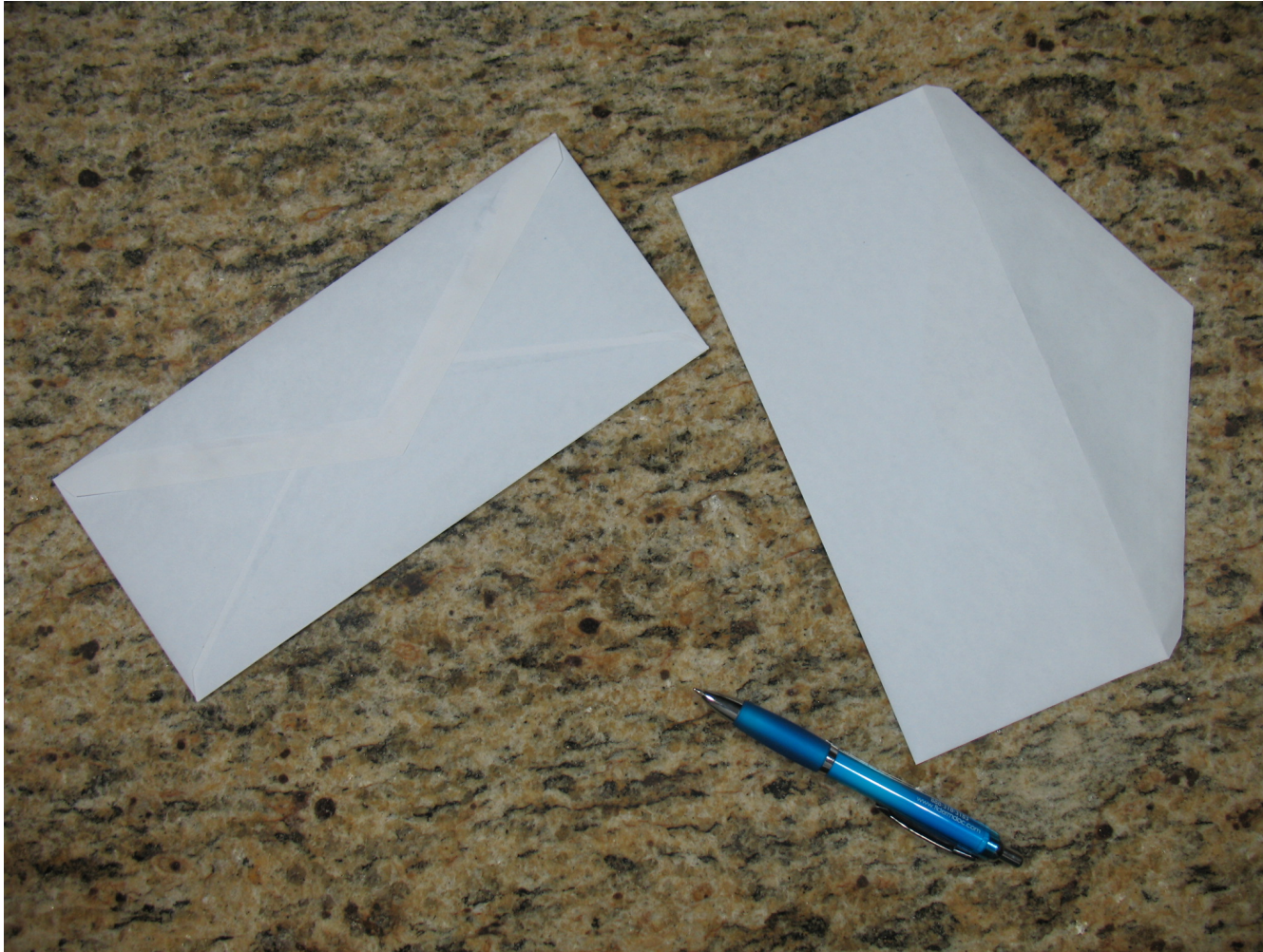
Step 1: Fill out your ballot.

Step 2: Put it into one of the envelopes.





Step 3: Seal the envelope, but DON'T write on it!



This step secures your ballot and ensures that your vote is anonymous.

Step 4: Place sealed envelope into the other envelope.



This step prepares your ballot to be mailed.



(It's OK if you have to fold the first envelope a bit to get it to fit in the second envelope.)



Step 5: Seal the envelope.  
Step 6: Print AND sign your name  
across the back seal.



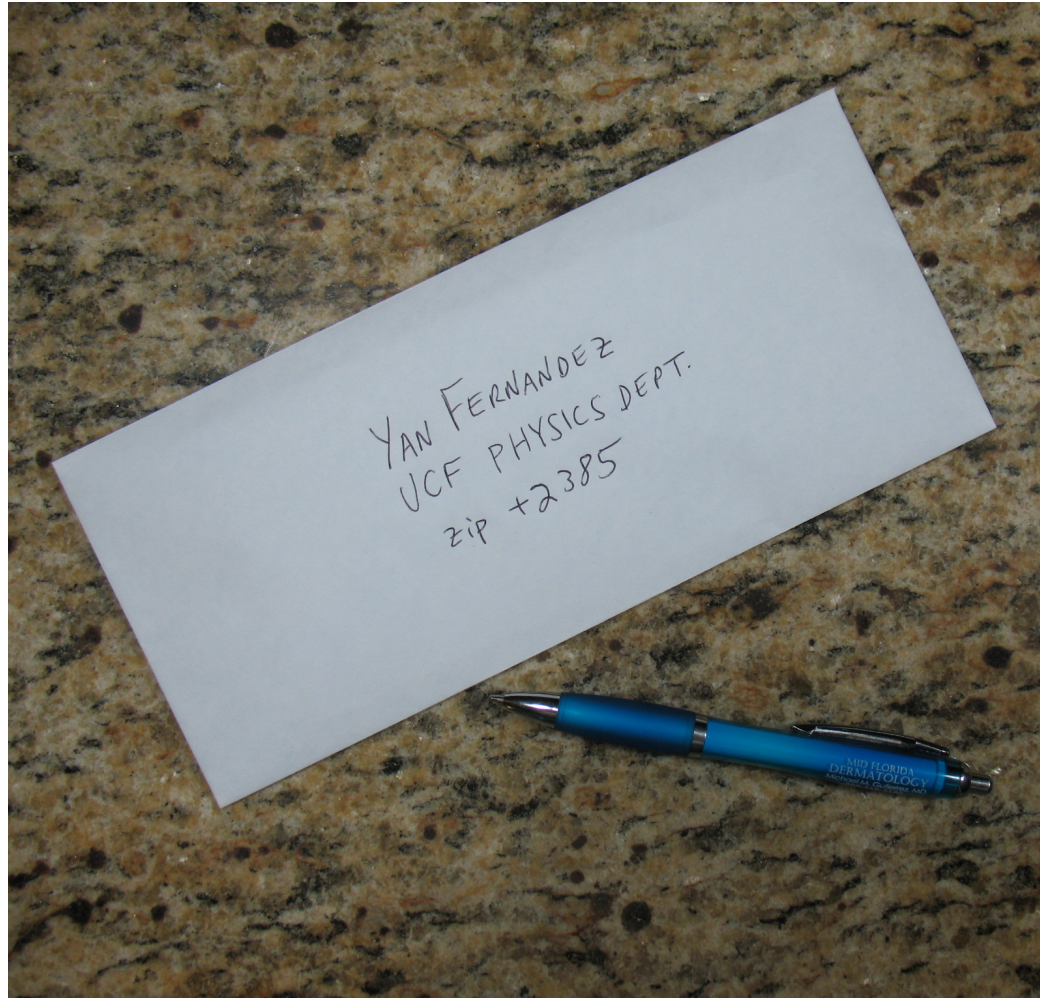


Step 6 allows verification that you are a dues-paying member of the bargaining unit, and therefore eligible to vote.

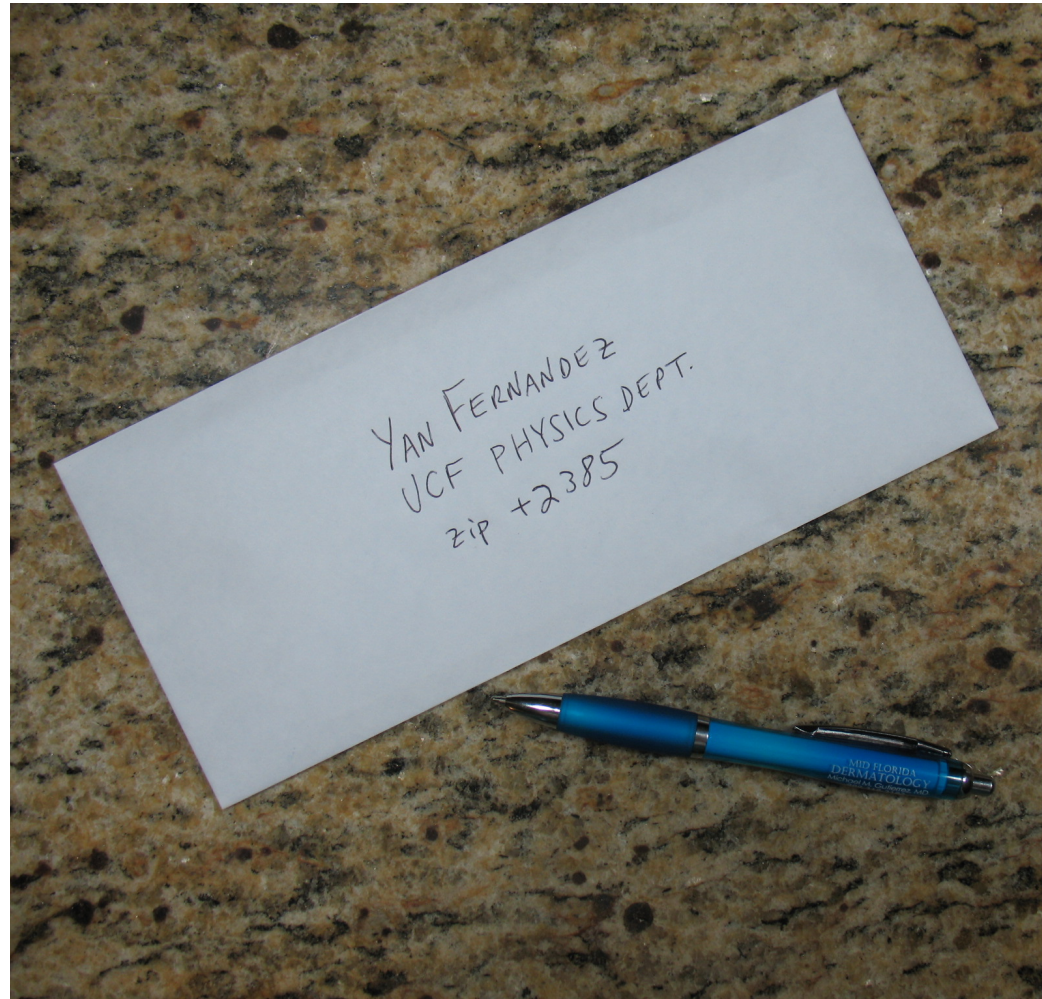




Step 7: Address the envelope and send it – by either Campus Mail or regular USPS – to...

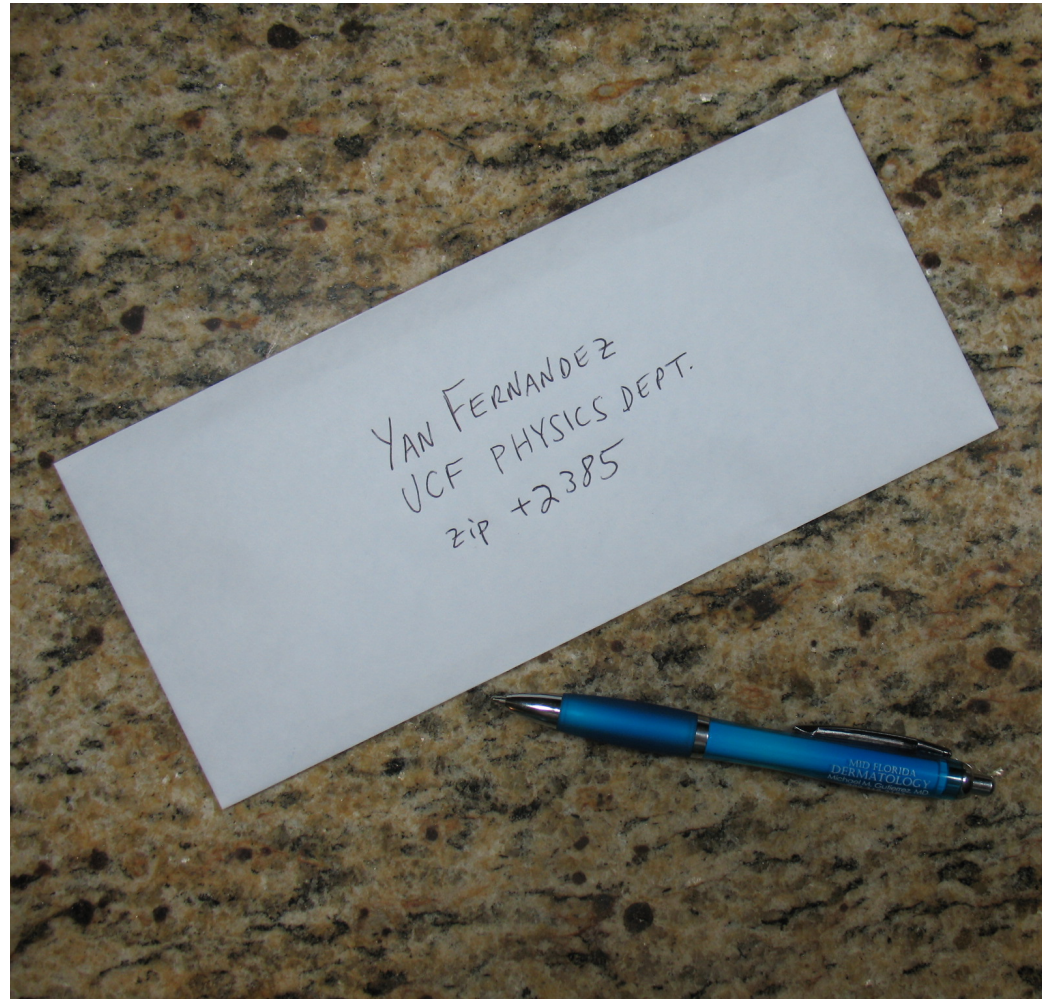

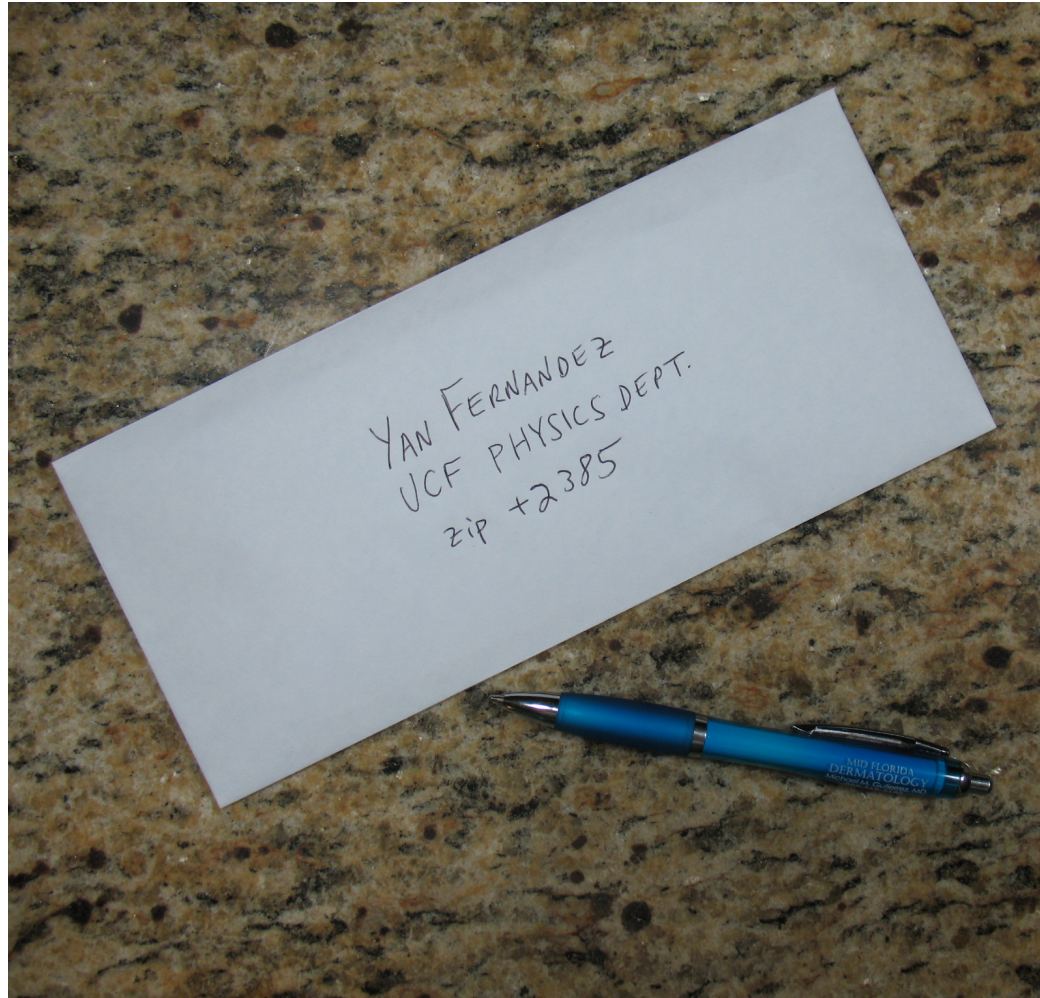
